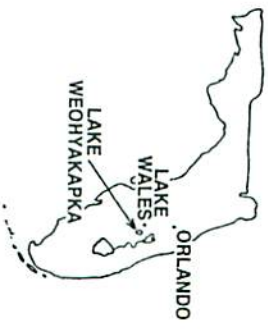


# LAKE WEOHYAKAPKA (Lake-Walk-In-Water)

Lake Weohyakapka (Walk-in-Water) used to be a sleeper among Bass lakes. The word is out on this fish factory. An abundance of hydrilla (green weeds) has helped to fuel a strong bait fish and Bass population. Keep in mind that areas of hydrilla are subject to change.
